INITIAL TEACHER EDUCATION

- pedagogical Higher Education study programmes
- non-pedagogical Higher Education study programmes with subsequent addition of pedagogical competences by completing the Additional Teaching Educational Programmes
- study programmes of Secondary Vocational Education
- study programmes of Higher Professional Education

Pedagogical Higher Education study programmes

- teaching of Academic Subjects
- teaching of Vocational Subjects and Practical Training
- teaching of Arts and Educational Subjects
- Pedagogy
- Pre-school and Elementary Education
- Special Education

Non-pedagogical Higher Education study programmes + Additional Teaching Educational Programmes

- most common in Professional Subjects
- completing non-pedagogical study programme
- subsequet or parallel study of Additional Teaching Educational Programme, which:
 - takes at least 200 lessons
 - contains at least 80% of pedagogy, psychology, social sciences, methodology of teaching
 - contains at least 40 lessons of teaching practice under supervision of experienced teacher

Study programmes of Secondary Vocational Education

- Full Secondary Vocational Education
- Study programmes for Pre-school Teachers in Kindergarten

Study programmes of Higher Professional Education

 graduates of Conservatories and Secondary Schools of artistic orientation are qualified to teach in Art School

CONTINUAL EDUCATION

- part of teachers lifelong learning
- professional development tool
- systematic process of acquiring knowledge, skills and competence
- AIM: keep, renew, improve, expand and complement of teachers professional competences that are necessary for educational activities

Providers of continual education

- school or school facility
- university or college
- organization established by the ministry to ensure or fulfill tasks of continual education
- educational organization of another central state administration body (e.g. ministry of interior, ministry of health...)
- church or religious society, or another private company which has education in the business activity

Educational programmes

- Providers of continual education offer educational programs for the development of teacher's professional competence in accordance with school reforms.
- Educational programmes has to be accredited by the Ministry.
- Teachers participate in continual education in accordance with annual school plan based on educational amis of the school.

TASKS FOR THE COMING PERIOD

- increase the attractiveness of the teaching profession
- revise the professional standards to ensure that teachers are highly professionally trained and motivated
- choise of the applicants for initial teacher education based on verification of their assumtions to become a good teacher

Attractiveness of the teaching profession

- criteria for determining the attractiveness of the teaching profession
- evaluate the current situation and propose a target state in the coming years
- adjustment of financial evaluation
- favorable working environment to promote quality of teachers' work
- strengthening freedom of teachers in the choice of forms and methods of education
- strengthening individual approach to pupils

Professional standards

- revise the professional standards
- if necessary improve it to ensure, that the expected changes in the school system will be realized by highly professionally trained and motivated teachers and other specialists
- create legislative changes in the system of continual education, credit system, career system and attestations in relation to teachers' professional standards

Applicants for initial teacher education

- standards for applicants for teaching study and graduates of teaching study
- suggest a way to enforce these standards of practice in higher education
- find a way to force universities to comply with the established rules
- take measures to guaranteeing high standards of applicants for teaching study and graduates of teaching study
- improve their preparation for the teaching profession at secondary schools and universities
- teachers can become only talented people ready for practice
