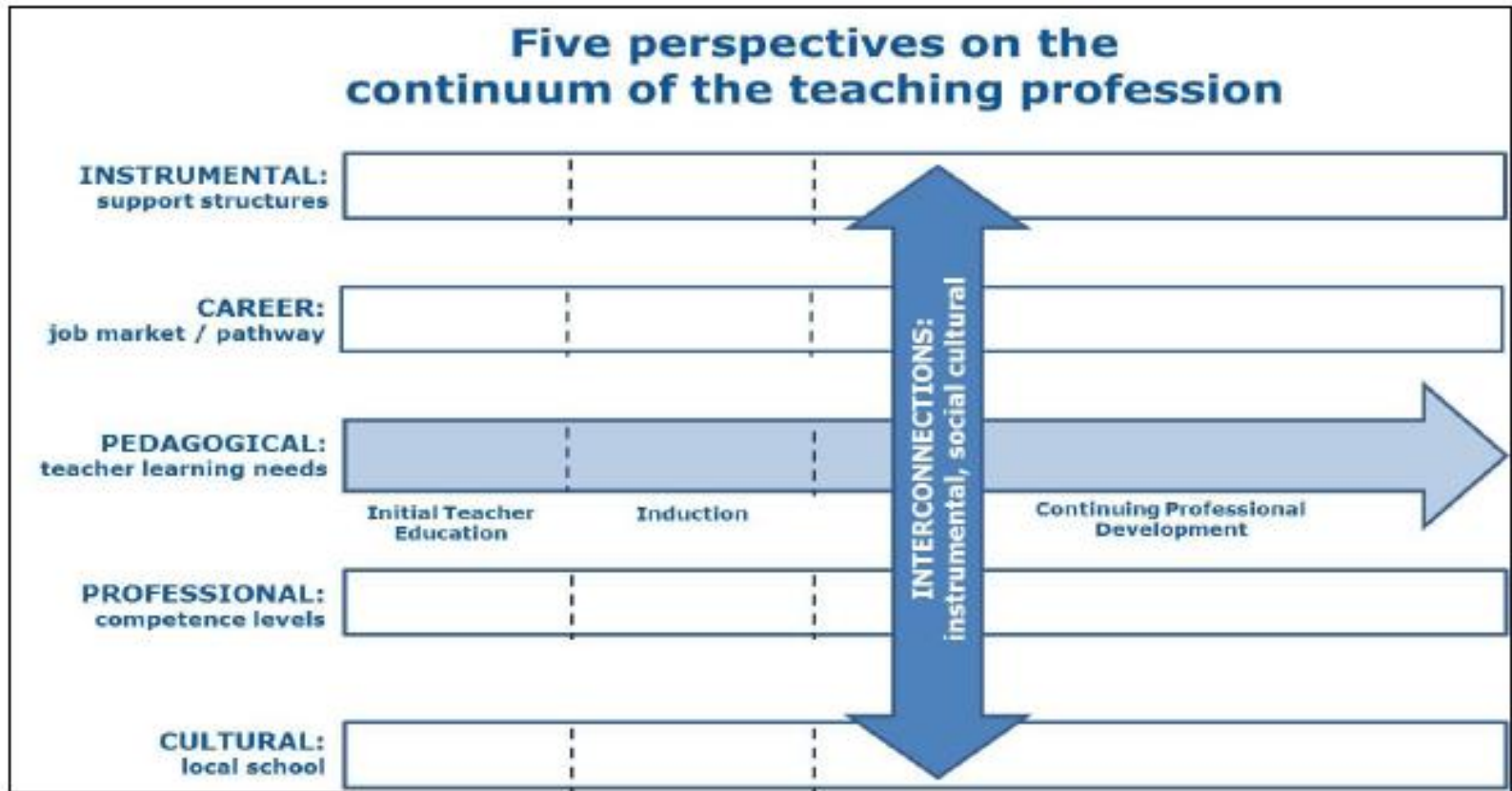

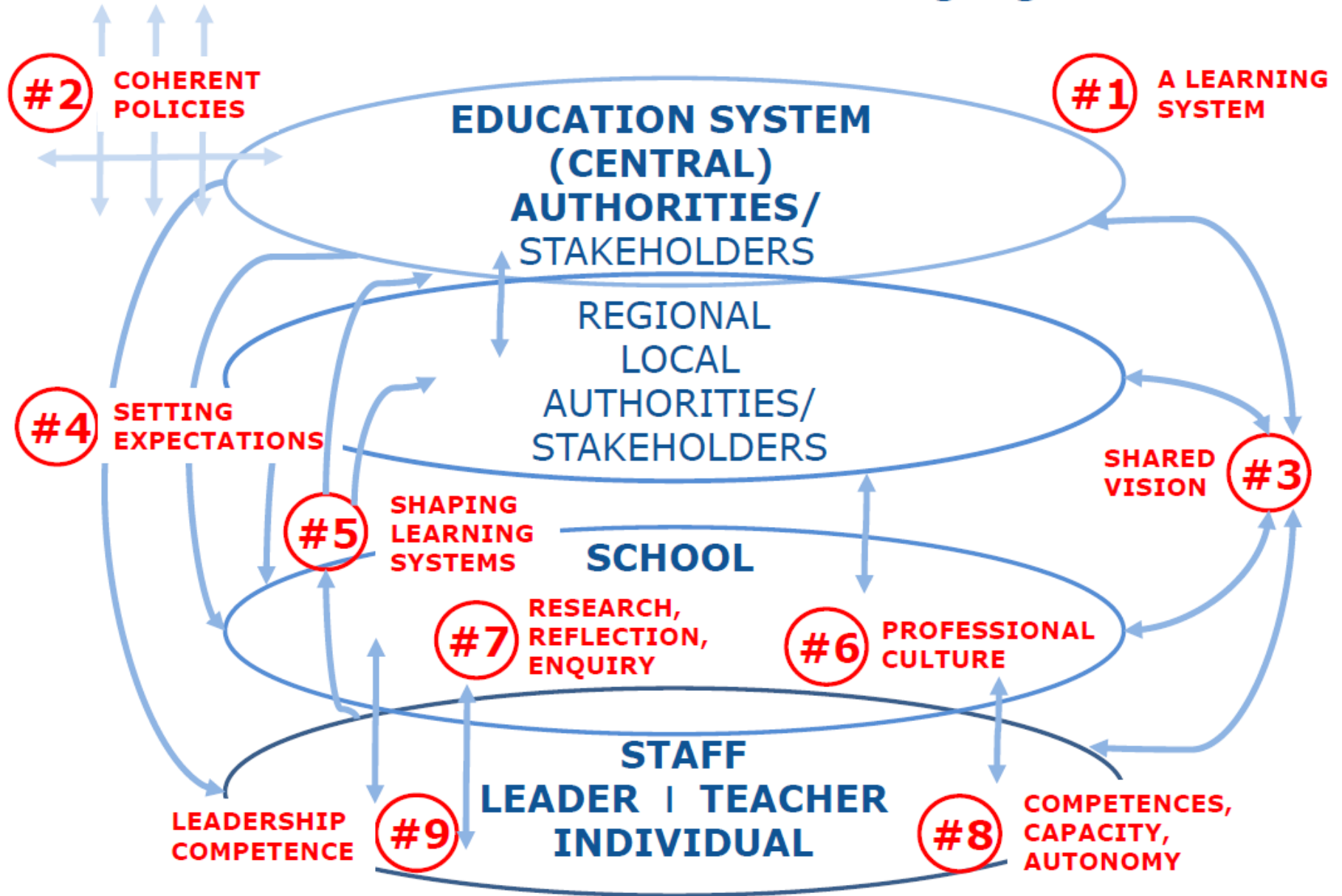


Figure 2: Five perspectives on the continuum of the teaching profession

Communication on school development and excellent teaching (May 2017)

1. **Results** of previous work: policy guidance (developed through ET2020)
2. **Agenda** for European co-operation
3. **EU action:** proposals for EU assistance to Member States, respecting subsidiarity



Need to act at three levels:

1. Developing better, more inclusive **schools**
2. Supporting **teachers and school leaders** for excellent teaching and learning
3. Governance of **school education systems:** more effective, equitable and efficient

- Eurydice report on **Teaching careers in Europe** (22 February 2018)
- Commission study on policy measures to support, develop and incentivise **teacher quality** (Spring 2018)
